

History

The Geotechnical Society of Paraguay (SPG) will be the organizer of this symposium. The Paraguayan Geotechnical Society is a non-profit scientific organization that was founded in 1978 for the advancement of the geotechnical engineering practice and research in Paraguay.

SPG and its members have contributed in large scale engineering projects such as the construction of the Itaipu and Yacyreta dams, as well as other important infrastructure projects in Paraguay. Additionally, it has promoted the study and diffusion of geotechnics and fostered the improvement of the geotechnical engineering profession and practice.

The SPG serves as Paraguay's National Group for the International Society for Soil Mechanics and Geotechnical Engineering (ISSMGE), the International Society for Rock Mechanics (ISRM) and the International Association for Engineering Geology and the Environment (IAEG) and is strongly linked to other national groups and societies for the exchange of knowledge and science

Venue

Asunción is Paraguay's historic capital city. It was first established as a fort in 1537, named Nuestra Señora Santa María de la Asunción, and later became the center of a large Spanish colonial province.
